Hopefully to start 2nd August. • For future positions- combine 10hrs at OGS with 6hrs at the library to comply with tax credit regulations. This opens it up for young mums etc. 	Sarah
Kirkgate Childcare and Tearooms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Storage to be reviewed between OGS, Dawn and Dawn S regarding the shelter, cellar and the roof space. OGS to be primary, Dawn and Dawn S secondary. Shelter to be sorted out before the end of August. 	
AOB <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks are still to be worn in the corridors/communal areas. For sessions, this will be up to the leaders. Hand sanitizers to remain. The toilets are to open properly, there will be no one way system and no track and trace. People will be asked to get their own tea and coffee. Windows will stay open for ventilation. Vera Watson room- max capacity 8-10 people, Ethel Smith room- max 6. This will be until further notice. Dawn is leaving the 	

screens in the Café.

- NO EXIT signs to be installed at the top of the inward lane.
